Training Courses Overview

Motion Sales Training

 This class is targeted at Sales people needing to learn about the product range and gain an insight into the motion capabilities and the tools used for commissioning,

Motion Programming Training Class Level 1

- This class is aimed at Support Engineers as a first step and for Technical Sales People wanting to gain more experience using motion products.
- The class focuses on basic programming techniques and a simple command set.
- Topics include:
 - ABB Motion product overview
 - WorkBench software
 - Getting started with Mint programming
 - Simple Motion Mint programs

Expert Class

 The Expert class is application based and provides opportunity to develop programming skills learned in the level 1 and level 2 Mint classes.

Motion Training for Service Engineers

- This class is targeted at Service engineers wanting to learn about the product range and gain some practical experience in installing and re-commissioning servo products.
- The software tools and the diagnostic features are covered in some detail.

Motion Programming Training Class Level 2

- This class is an extension of Level 1, it is targeted at support engineers and covers most of the more complex programing methods available in the Mint programming language (Level 1 is a pre-requisite).
 - Topics include:
 - Advanced motion
 - Communications to PC, PLC and other devices
 - Introduction to Windows Motion programming using ActiveX
 - Drive tuning

Intensive Class

 This is a combination of all other classes run over 4 consecutive weeks to allow a fast track training program.
 Additional material and extended exercises are included in the intensive program for greater development of programming skills.
