Title: How to handle the event "37503 – Mass memory storage error"

This affects mainly IRC5 controllers with RW installation of RW6.02.xx/RW6.03.

<u>Do not replace SD card if event "37503 - Mass memory storage error" occur when or after installing RobotWare.</u>

One operating system component is updated only by the Boot Application, and only when the power supply USB cable is attached to the Main Computer.

## **Recommended action:**

If the event "37503 - Mass memory storage error" is shown at every startup after an installation/upgrade to RW6.02.xx or RW6.03, then the controller needs to be restarted to the Boot Application and from there restarted with your system selected again.

## **Procedure:**

- Make sure that the power supply USB cable is attached to the Main Computer.
- Restart -> Advanced... -> select Start Boot Application -> Next -> Start Boot Application (then wait for the Boot Application to startup)
- Select System -> select your system -> Select -> Close
- Restart Controller -> OK

After that the error 37503 should not be displayed at every startup with a genuine ABB Robotics SD card.
