

CHINA COMPULSORY CERTIFICATE MARK

Question:

Is the CCC Mark needed for ABB Drive products used in China and what is the purpose for the mark?

Answer:

The CCC mark is a compulsory safety mark that is required for many items that are imported, used, or sold in the Chinese market that is in some ways like CE. It is not however, currently required for ABB low voltage drives products.

The CCC authority does not accept our CCC application at this time because there are no measurable CCC standards for our drive products.

ABB's low voltage drive products comply with related international standards and have the CE and UL mark for them. ABB also complies with the China national product standard GB/T 12668.

ABB shall immediately take action to get the CCC certificate if our products are placed into the CCC product catalog or if it is required by the China CCC authority.
